Pageant Categories and attire

There are two (2) scored categories in the pageant. The maximum number of points that a contestant can receive is 10 points per judge per category.

All judges are out of town and have no affiliation

❖ Interview (40% of overall score) — A 5 minute Private Interview with the judging panel.

The Private Interview phase of competition is an opportunity to learn as much as possible about the contestant - her personal qualities and attributes; her level of communication skills; her opinions and aspirations; her sense of accomplishment, poise, presence, "first impression"; responses; ability to fulfill the duties and responsibilities. (No Interview for Petite Miss)

• *Opening Number* — Opening number is a time for the contestant's personality to shine without being judged. It is the first impression made on stage, but under a low-pressure setting. Attire: TBD

Evening Wear (60% of overall score)

The Evening Wear phase of competition is designed for the judge to assess the contestant's poise, grace, and stage presence. The contestant's total look is considered. Her evening wear (not the value of the evening wear) should complement the contestant's individuality. Overall "first impression"; sense of confidence; personality and stage presence; walk, carriage and grace; sense of style and appropriateness of the evening wear.
