

ISRAEL PRAYER GUIDE

- We pray for all the Jewish People around the world who are responding to the prophetic call to return to the land of Israel in these Last Days (Is 11:10-16), and for their protection and settlement.

ANTI-SEMITISM

- We pray for people to understand and value the Jewish People as God does (Rm 9:4-5).
- We ask that the LORD will be a refuge for the Jewish People, that He will keep them from harm and execute righteousness and judgment on their behalf (Ps 9:9; Ps 103:6).

THE CHURCH

- We pray that Gentile Believers would by their lives provoke Israel to jealousy (Rm 11:11).
- We pray that You Oh Lord will not forsake Your people for Your great Name's sake, because it has pleased the Lord to make Israel His people. (1Sm 12:22) Use them to help others understand Your plan for Israel and Your love for the Jewish people.
- We pray that the Church would understand God's heart and plans for Israel and the Jewish People, and stand with them (Gn 12:3).
- We earnestly pray that the false teaching of replacement theology would be exposed and abandoned (Rm 11; 1, 27-29; Ep 4:14).
- We pray that the Church would understand and embrace the Hebraic roots of Christianity (Rm 4:16; Rm 11:17), that Gentile Believers would experience life together with Jewish Believers as One New Man (Ep 2:14-15; Rm 15:5-6, 13)
- Father, cause the church to fulfill its commission to preach the Gospel to the whole world, so the full number of the Gentiles would come into the Kingdom. Then all Israel will be saved (Rm 11:25–26).

OUR NATION

- We pray for our government and leaders (1Tm 2:1-4), and ask that You give our president and leaders wisdom concerning aligning with and supporting Israel. We pray for courage to bless, protect and stand with Israel. We pray for accurate perception of Your will concerning the land of Israel which belongs to the Jewish people through Your Covenant.
- We pray that our nation would strengthen its ties with Israel and seek ways to bless her (Gn 12:3), turn to God, make godly decisions based on biblical principles.
- We pray that Israel's relationship with the United States be strong, and may our nation—and especially young believers—recognize and support God's purposes for Israel.
- Lord, we ask that young believers in America would come to love the Jewish people as they seek to prepare the way for the return of Messiah.
- Father, teach us how to pray in unity with You and with each other over Israel and Your precious Jewish people at this important time.

THE NATION AND PEOPLE OF ISRAEL

- We pray for the peace of Jerusalem (Ps 122:6) and for it to remain Israel's undivided capital.
- We pray for the citizens of Israel to seek God for the welfare of their nation and its cities, so they will prosper (Jr 29:7).
- We pray for the people of Israel to come to know their Messiah, Yeshua (Ps 40:7; Is 53).
- Father God, remove the veil You have sovereignly placed over the eyes of Israel, that they would recognize Jesus as Yeshua. (2Cor 3:14).
- Lord, show Your mercy and favor to Israel in this set time (Ps 102:13).
- He who scattered Israel will gather him, and will keep him as a shepherd keeps his flock. (Jr 31:10) Father, in Your will continue to draw the Jewish people to You.
- We pray for the fulfillment of Jerusalem's future glory, that God would continue to raise intercessors to call on the LORD for her to be established. (Is 62:1, 6).
- We pray for Jerusalem to never to be divided and her borders secure (Ex 23:31, Jl 3:2).
- Father, bring glory to Your Name through the mercy You show to the land. Bring the necessary seasonal rain upon the country. Cause the crops to be bountiful.
- We pray through the midst of the pressures, Israel will turn to You, God. We pray that You will hear the heart cries of the people in this land and have mercy. As it says in Isaiah 30:19, "You shall weep no more. He will be very gracious to you at the sound of your cry. When He hears it, He will answer."
- Father, pour out Your Ruach Ha Kodesh/Your Holy Spirit upon the people of Israel—especially upon the young people so that your works can be declared to future generations. Raise up "sons of Zion" who take God's Word seriously in opposition to the humanistic "sons of Greece" (Zec 9:13).
- Turn the hearts of the people of Israel to trust in the name of the Lord for deliverance—not in the "chariots and horses" of their military might (Zec 4:6).
- We pray that the Palestinian Arabs will come to faith in Yeshua and embrace God's end-time purpose for Israel; send forth laborers to bring in the appointed harvest from the whole of the Middle East.

ISRAEL'S GOVERNMENT AND LEADERS

- We pray for the leaders in Israel, including the Prime Minister, the mayor of Jerusalem, and all those in military service. Raise up government leaders in Israel (and worldwide) who will not seek to “divide the land,” and who would recognize the unique significance of Jerusalem in God’s end-time purposes.
- We pray for a radical change in the Israeli system of government, that divisiveness and partisanship would give way to unity and cooperation; grant wisdom and revelation to all members of the Knesset and Israel’s Supreme Court.
- We pray for Israel’s leaders to be blessed and to lead well, so Israel’s citizens can live in peace and many will come to salvation (1Ti 2:1-4); that they may be just and give their country stability, and be free from corruption (Pr 29:4).
- We pray for righteous unity and like-mindedness among the leaders and citizens, and that the leaders would have understanding and knowledge to maintain order (Pr 28:2)
- We pray for Israel’s leaders to keep good companions and listen to good advisors, and also to delight in the word of the LORD and study it diligently (Ps1:1-2) that they would ask God for wisdom and follow His lead (Jm 1:5).

BELIEVERS IN THE LAND OF ISRAEL

- We pray for the Believers in Israel to be strengthened with power in their inner being, so Messiah may dwell in their hearts through faith, and that they would know His love (Ep 3:16-19).
- We pray that they would be filled with God’s will, wisdom and understanding; live a life worthy of Him; bear fruit in every good work; have great patience; and be grateful (Cl 2:6-7), that God would complete the amazing work He is doing in and through them (Phi 1:3-6), that they would get along with each other and shine like lights in this crooked and perverse world (Ph 2:14-15), for their protection, and that those around them would be drawn to Yeshua because of their love for Him and one another (Jn 17:11, 23).

THE YOUTH AND THE ELDERLY

- We ask that You Lord would comfort the young and old alike (Is 40:1), for them to experience the Lord’s comfort and compassion, and rejoice! (Is 49:13), and that they would know the Lord desires to give them hope and a future, not evil (Jr 29:11).

FRIENDS AND ENEMIES OF ISRAEL

- We pray that people and nations will take this Scripture to heart and bless Israel, thus receiving a blessing and not a curse (Gn 12:3) and understand the depth of God’s wrath against those who don’t follow Him (Is 60:12).
- We pray that You would keep a watchful eye over Your People, and bind the schemes and resources of their enemies so they can do them no harm (Zec 12:1-5; Ps 91).
- Lord, destroy and divide the tongues of those who would incite violence against Israel. (Ps 55:9) In the name of Yeshua, we bind every false religion and false doctrine that does not acknowledge Your eternal plan for the land and people of Israel.

The scepter of the wicked will not remain over the land allotted to the righteous. (Ps 125:3) Father, break the strongholds of religion, pride and wickedness that seek to control Israel.

- Show Your lovingkindness to Your people Israel and keep them as the apple of Your eye. Hide them under the shadow of Your wings, from the wicked who oppress them, from their deadly enemies who surround them (Ps 17:7–9).
- We pray that You would remember your covenants and promises towards Israel, especially when others rise up against her to swallow her alive. When their wrath is kindled against her, the waters will not overwhelm her. God will not give her as prey to their teeth (Ps 124).
- We pray for a spirit of unity—for peace between religious and secular Jews, for peace to exist between believers in the land.

JEWISH PEOPLE THROUGHOUT THE WORLD • SALVATION

- We pray Lord that You would deepen the desires of believers that Jewish People throughout the world would be saved (Rm 10:1) and not be ashamed of the Gospel, but to share its saving power with everyone, Jewish People first and also Gentiles, so they have opportunity to believe (Rm 1:16). Lord, pour out a spirit of grace and supplication, so that many will see Yeshua and mourn for Him, having a full revelation of who He is (Zec 12:10-14).
- We pray that the Jewish People would call on the Lord and be saved and blessed (Rm 10:12-13), that they would turn to the Lord so the veil would be taken away (2Co 3:16).

MESSIANIC MOVEMENT AROUND THE WORLD

- We pray for the body of Messiah in Israel to become a praying, maturing body. We pray that this body would allow the love and compassion of Yeshua to flow through them and touch everyone they encounter.
- Lord, raise up intercessors for Israel. Put more watchmen on the walls of Jerusalem, who would give You no peace day or night until You establish Jerusalem and make her the praise of the earth. (Is 62:6–7).
- We pray that Jewish Believers in Yeshua would be filled with the knowledge of God through all spiritual wisdom and understanding, bearing fruit and giving thanks (Cl 1:9-12), for wisdom and revelation to know Him better and to know the hope, riches and power available to them as Believers (Ep 1:15-19), for their hearts to be set on things above (Cl 3:1-4) that wherever they are and wherever they go, they will rely on the LORD, and preach the word boldly, with signs and wonders (Ac 14:3).
