## **Letter from the President**

2021 has been an interesting year of starts and stops and starts again. Although Covid stopped many of our activities, we were still able to do some good things in 2021.

The book sales at Delaware will be forever changed because we have revamped the garage at Delaware and turned it into more of a bookstore and less of a warehouse of boxes. We have shelves with books on them. People can browse looking up rather than looking down. The Delaware book sale was our first book sale in over a year. It is good to be back.

2021 was a banner year for authors. We hosted Annie Lyons, author of The Brilliant Life of Eudora Honeysett; Fiona Davis, New York Times best selling author of many books including The Lions of Fifth Avenue; Kate Quinn and Martha Hall Kelly – Kate is a New York Times best-selling author of several books including The Rose Code, and Martha is a best-selling author with her latest book Sunflower Sisters. The year was capped by a three author visit by Connie Berry, Robin Yocum and Andrew Welsh-Huggins. All are local authors and all are mystery writers. We also ventured into a new venue by hosting Connie, Robin and Andrew at III Mannered Brewery in Powell – Authors and Ales. I am sure that we will do more authors at different event venues.

Although major fundraisers were not on the calendar for 2021, we still managed to raise money through our Spring and Holiday flower sales, our children's book sale at Powell Street Market, and our lobby book sales. And we hosted our first Members' picnic at Orange Library. George Needham talked and dedicated the Gazebo at Orange, which was paid for by a patron donation and a donation from Friends of the Library. We will have more member events in 2022.
