The Friends Zoomed with author Sara Nisha Adams from England in February 2022 about her new debut novel *The Reading List*. The book featured the importance of libraries and reading amongst a group of diverse and struggling people, and the role of libraries in bringing people together in hard times. Twenty-three paid attendees enjoyed the charming presentation from the gracious new novelist.

Our first in-person event in a few years occurred in April 2022 as we hosted NYT best-selling author William Kent Krueger at the Stratford Barn in Delaware. Over 130 people attended to hear Kent's heartwarming and inspiring talk about the importance of reading and libraries in his life. Kent spent a few formative years in nearby Worthington. A luncheon was held the same day featuring Lightning Strike, the prequel to his mystery series. Kent chatted with his fans and graciously signed copies of all his titles including Ordinary Grace and This Tender Land at both events. We received extremely positive feedback on his visit.
