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# **WHO WE ARE**

#### **OUR HISTORY**

Family Support Network of Central Carolina (FSNCC) was organized in 1989 by a coalition of parents, medical professionals, and staff from community agencies serving children with disabilities and their families. We are one of twelve affiliates of Family Support Network of North Carolina. We serve families living in Guilford, Alamance, Caswell, Randolph, and Rockingham counties.

#### **OUR MISSION**

Our mission is to provide support, education, and caring connections to those who have a child with a disability, special healthcare needs, or have experienced a NICU stay.

Families with children who have special healthcare needs often encounter added stress, social isolation, and financial strain, which can complicate their child's health journey and hinder their access to social and emotional support.

### **OUR APPROACH**

Our comprehensive approach supports and empowers families by fostering connections, advocating for their needs, providing education, and forming community partnerships.

Our **NICU Support Program**, located within Cone Health Women's and Children's Center NICU, is a vital resource for NICU parents. Our dedicated NICU Staff, composed of experienced former NICU moms, serve as trained peer-to-peer specialists. They offer crucial information and steadfast support to parents facing the challenges of the NICU journey.

Our comprehensive programs include:

- Personal Support: Families receive emotional support and essential resources like informative pamphlets, online resources, and custom support material.
- Baby Basics: Offering baby supplies and resources to families preparing for discharge.
- Education: Promoting the benefits of early literacy with our Books for Babies program, explaining the ABCs of Safe Sleep, and the importance of caregiver wellness.
- **Home Visitation**: Providing in-home support and guidance to families transitioning from the NICU to home.
- Parent-to-Parent Mentor: Providing one-on-one peer support from experienced parents.
- Sibling Bags: Supporting siblings of NICU babies with activities, toys, and resources.
- Special Events: Hosting meals and activities for NICU families to offer respite and encourage connections.

Our **Disability Support Program** at FSNCC is founded on a strong commitment to help parents and siblings of children with disabilities or special healthcare needs. Through this program we offer a variety of services and resources aimed at supporting families as they navigate these challenges, ensuring they have access to essential support, guidance, and care.

Our programs include:

- Resources and Referrals: Equipping families with valuable information and connecting them with relevant resources.
- Parent Groups: A platform for parents to connect, share experiences, and learn from one another within our 4 parent groups.
- Parent Mentor Program: Providing one-on-one support from experienced, trained parents who have been through similar journeys.
- Sibshops: Offering a supportive space for siblings to connect with peers who understand their unique experiences.

Our parent groups offer a nurturing and inclusive space for parents to connect, share experiences, and gain valuable insights, providing support, guidance, and a sense of community to those navigating the NICU or raising children with disabilities or special healthcare needs.

**Moms Group**: A supportive environment exclusively for mothers, to openly discuss their experiences while caring for children with disabilities or special healthcare needs.

**Dads Group**: Provides a space for fathers to connect and learn from one another, building a supportive community and offering a chance to unwind and relax together.

**Rare Disease Moms Group**: Dedicated to families dealing with rare diseases, this group provides a focused platform for sharing knowledge, resources, and emotional support.

**Black Parents Group**: A safe haven for Black parents and caregivers, offering resources, and the opportunity to connect with others who share similar experiences.

**Sibshops:** Sibshops is a supportive program tailored for kids in grades 1-6 who have siblings with disabilities. It provides a safe space for them to connect, share experiences, and learn coping skills while engaging in fun activities.

Our annual events and campaigns enhance our programs, benefiting over **1,000** families yearly. They also foster a strong sense of community among our supporters, all dedicated to positively impacting lives.



Our annual U.N.I.T.E. (Understanding the Needs of Inclusion Takes Everyone), festival features family-friendly activities, games, and live music, where various organizations serving families of individuals with disabilities or special healthcare needs come together to provide valuable resources.



Holiday Jamboree is our annual special holiday event for our families of children with a disability, special healthcare needs, or families who experienced a NICU stay. It is a wonderful opportunity for parents to receive resources and connect with other families in the community with similar experiences.



#### POKER FOR PREEMIES AND PEDS

Poker for Preemies and Peds is a joint fundraiser by FSNCC and Cone Health Pediatrics, offering a fun evening of casino games, hors d'oeuvres, raffles, and a silent auction. All proceeds support families who have experienced NICU stays or have children with disabilities or special healthcare needs.

We offer special events throughout the year that provide engaging activities, access to community resources, and serve as an opportunity to raise awareness and garner support for parents caring for children with special healthcare needs.
